The entire proceeds of the State Aid towards repayment of the scheduled pension loan payment of \$419,260.84.

And the additional payments as follows are paid out of the Township General Fund:

Non-Uniformed Pension Plan Distribution: \$79,286.00

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Police Pension Plan Distribution: \$162,758.00

Pension Loan Payment: \$121,829.32
